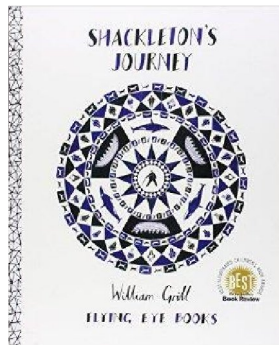


Our New Creative Learning Journey in Year 5.....

LITERACY, COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Our focus this half term will be around the book "Shackleton's Journey" by William Grill. The children will explore the book through the use of drama, developing their ideas using different techniques. These will then be used to develop a variety of writing opportunities, such as letters, diaries, recruitment adverts and newspaper reports.



UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD



As our book this half term is all about Geography and exploration, we will be focusing on using atlases to master our understanding of the world. We will also begin a new topic on biology, looking at

planning and carrying out investigations.

PSHE AND RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This half term, the children will be discussing aspirations and goals for the future. They will also develop their social skills through regular R Time, circle and philosophy session.

MATHEMATICS AND COMPUTING



Throughout this half term the children will be focusing on their understanding of place value and number. They will be looking at developing their skills through the use of problem solving as well as thinking carefully about their use of reasoning. They will then be looking at addition and subtraction, applying their knowledge through the use of the class book. For Maths Minutes we will be mastering time.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN



As our topic focuses on

exploration the children will be investigating food that is intended for expeditions. This will help them to develop their understanding of healthy meals and attitudes. In addition to this, the children will be composing their own pieces of music based on sea shanties.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION



The children will be focusing on developing their attacking and defending skills through the use of hockey.
