#### Tackling Headlice

Just as a reminder, in order to eradicate headlice, everyone must check and treat!

GPs are able to offer prevention advice and can prescribe medication if required. Also, prescriptions for headlice can be given by Health Visitors at all weigh-in sessions at the Children's Centre on Wolfe Road. The Health Visitor would need to see your child first.

The bites from headlice can quickly become infected and lead to medical complications, so please treat your child as soon as you notice they have headlice.

Please check your child's head daily.
