

Horstead!

The Year 6 children have had a fantastic week at Horstead! They all thoroughly enjoyed the experience (even if they did get a bit wet!) They had lots of fun and centre staff commented on how polite and well-behaved they were. Well done Year 6!

Attendance

There is clear link between your child's attendance at school and their levels of achievement so it is important that they are in school regularly. Here are some easy to remember guidelines.

High temperature

If your child has a raised temperature they should stay off school. Once their temperature is normal they can return to school the next day if there are no other symptoms of concern.

Vomiting and Diarrhoea

Your child should not return to school until they have been free of symptoms for 48 hours.

Cough, minor cold or sore throat.

If your child appears to be coughing or complains of a sore throat but has no other symptoms they are probably fine to come to school. If you are unsure if your child is well enough to come to school please bring them in. If they develop a raised temperature, or we have concerns that they are too unwell to remain in school, we will contact you.

When leaving a message on the absence line please ensure you give a specific reason for their absence. In the event of the given reason being 'unwell' or 'not coming to school today' it is necessary for us to contact you by phone for more information.

If you have any questions, please let us know.

Don't forget Forest School takes place on Tuesdays for Year 3. If your child is taking part you should have already received a letter. We will go to the woods in all weather (apart from when there are high winds). Make sure that children bring in warm and waterproof coats, wellies or old shoes and old clothes.

Crucial Crew

On Thursday 21st September Year 6 will be travelling to the Norfolk Showground for Crucial Crew, where they will learn about safety. Your child should have had a letter about this.

Year 4 children have the opportunity to go swimming this term. If your child has been chosen this term, then you will already have received a letter. Swimming takes place on Tuesdays. Please ensure your child has a towel and trunks/shorts for boys and a full swimsuit (no bikinis) for girls.

Cycling Proficiency

The Year 6 children will be given the opportunity to take part in a cycling proficiency course this term. If you wish your child to take part, they will need their bikes and helmets in school on the following dates:
