Year 3's English work this term will be based around the book Jemmy Button. The children will use drama to deepen their understanding of the text, as well as writing descriptive poetry and letters.

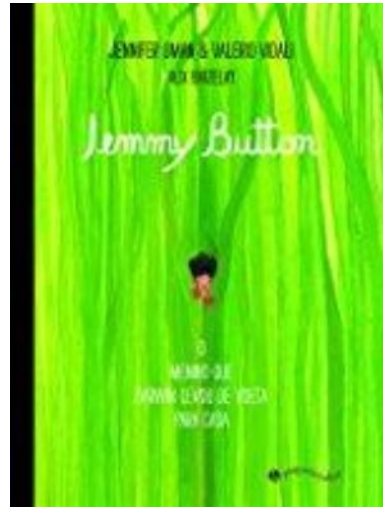
Understanding of the World
