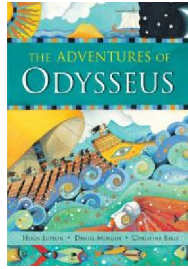


Our New Creative Learning Journey in Year 5 is.....

LITERACY, COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

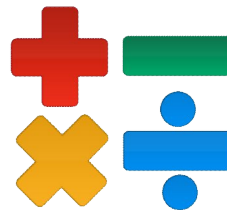
This half term our Power of Reading book will be 'The Adventures of Odysseus'.



We will explore the characters and themes within this story to inspire our own writing. The children will develop writing for different purposes, such as story writing and character descriptions. There will be daily lessons of spelling, punctuation and grammar.

MATHEMATICS AND COMPUTING

During this half term we will continue to concentrate on number. We will be revising the four operations with a specific focus on



multiplication and division. Year 5 also practise arithmetic daily to develop reasoning skills and to revise previous areas such as fractions.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD



We will be learning about Ancient Greece as our focus topic for this area.

The children will develop their enquiry skills in Geography and History while finding out about Ancient Greece and the origins of different Myths and Legends.

In Science we will be using 'Empiribox' to investigate biology and the children will develop their scientific knowledge and conceptual understanding of the human body.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN



The children will have the opportunity to use a range of media to recreate popular art from Ancient Greece such as mosaics, pot designs and landscape paintings.

PSHE

The children will explore and comment on different playground scenarios and will learn to communicate and respond to each other's ideas in a positive and constructive way. We will also discuss some current affairs with the children daily.
