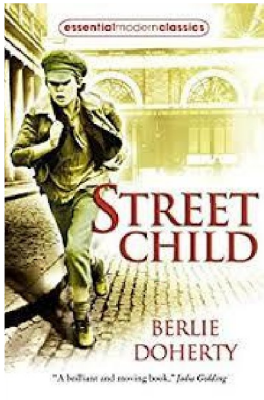

LITERACY, COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

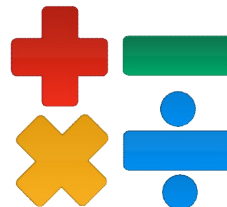


This half term our Power of Reading book will be 'Street Child'. We will explore the characters and themes within this story to inspire our own writing. The children will develop writing for different purposes, such as

newspaper reports. There will be daily lessons of spelling, punctuation and grammar.

MATHEMATICS AND COMPUTING

During this half term we will be revising the four operations and calculation strategies and applying these in problem solving contexts. We



will have daily arithmetic practice to develop fluency of mental and written calculations. We will also explore fractions, decimals and percentages.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

In Science we will be learning about human health and fitness. The children will develop their scientific knowledge and conceptual understanding of biology.



We will also be looking into some of the scientific discoveries and inventions made during the Victorian period.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

The children will develop their observation skills in guided drawing, alongside their pencil control. They will work with charcoal as a medium for exploring still life.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION



This half term we will be focusing on Gymnastics. During Real PE sessions, the children will build on team-work skills and effective tactics. Please remember to have a named PE kit at school all week.

PSHE AND RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We will be concentrating on forming positive relationships in this area. The children will use R-Time activities to develop their co-operation and respect when interacting with peers. We will also think about the rights of modern children in comparison to Victorian children.



Your child will receive three pieces of homework each week to practise quick arithmetic, spelling and grammar topics and comprehension skills.
