School clothes

If you have any clothes that your child has borrowed from school please can they be returned to your child's class.

Any donations of spare clothes to the school are also welcome.

Sickness and Absence

High temperature

If your child has a raised temperature they should stay off school. Once their temperature is normal they can return to school the next day if there are no other symptoms of concern.

Vomiting and Diarrhoea

Your child should not return to school until they have been free of symptoms for 48 hours.

Cough, minor cold or sore throat.

If your child appears to be coughing or complains of a sore throat but has no other symptoms they are probably fine to come to school. If you are unsure if your child is well enough to come to school please bring them in. If they develop a raised temperature, or we have concerns that they are too unwell to remain in school, we will contact you.

Finally, thank you to the majority of our parents who call the school to let us know their child is unwell. When leaving a message on the absence line please ensure you give a specific reason for their absence. In the event of the given reason being 'unwell' or 'not coming to school today' it is necessary for us to contact you by phone for more information.

Parents' Group

The Parents' Group meet every Tuesday between 9am - 11am at Lionwood Infant & Nursery School.

Road Safety

Road Safety outside the school remains a concern.

It is important that it is safe for our children and families to cross the road so please refrain from parking on the zig zag lines outside the school, or blocking the road and/or school car park entrance, to drop off children.

Please also note that the car park is for staff only.

Following reported concerns with unsafe parking last week, our local PCSO's are expected to make random visits at drop-off and collection times.

Also, please make sure that children are safely strapped into suitable safety seats when they are being driven to and from school.
