


## Our New Creative Learning Journey in Year 4.....

# Vicious Vikings

### LITERACY, COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

This half term the children will be exploring the book 'Arthur and the Golden Rope'. The children will use this to inspire them to create their own myths and legends, which they will write as stories and play scripts. They will learn how to correctly use direct speech in their writing.



### MATHEMATICS AND COMPUTING



We will be focusing on multiplication and division this half term. Children will learn to use the grid method for multiplying larger numbers and a numberline to divide. They will also continue to improve their knowledge of times tables and division facts.

### UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD



Through our book, we will be learning about the Vikings. The children will


compare Modern and Viking settlements and look at how Vikings shaped the world. We will look at mythical beasts from around the world and their origins.

### EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

The children will design and create a Viking longboat and artefacts from modrock. They will design their own mythical beasts and create them from clay. We will also listen to and comment on Viking music.



### PSHE AND RELIGIOUS EDUCATION



Through the use of R Time, Circle Time and class council sessions the children will be focusing on developing their understanding of how to keep themselves healthy and hygenic.

### PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Our focus for PE this half term will be on dance. The children will create and perform dances to Viking music. In real PE, we will develop our cognition in PE to improve our tactics. We will improve our dynamic balance and coordination skills.

### HOMEWORK

Each week, the children will be given three pieces of homework to complete. Maths and spellings will be given every week, with a due date that is usually a week later. Comprehension and CLJ homework will alternate each week and are usually given two weeks to complete.
