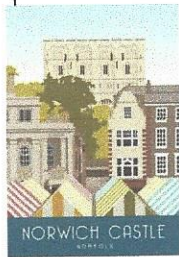


There will be no one manning the crossing on Tuesday 24th April. Please take extra care when crossing the road.
