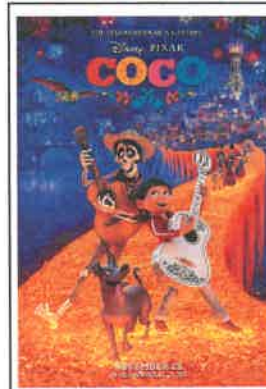
Well done!

What we have been learning ...

Year 3: Have been learning about 'what makes a good friend'. How to hold a balance and create sequences in P.E. World War 1 poetry in English and subtraction in Maths—sound like a busy week!

Year 4: The Year 4 children have learnt about environmental regions around the world. In Maths they used a number line for their subtraction work and they have learnt the history around Guy Fawkes and bonfire night.

Year 5: In their Science they have been learning about Adaptation and Inheritance. In Maths using written methods for multiplication and in English they have been writing instructions on how to look after a war horse.

Year 6: The children have researched Armistice Day and created dialogue between soldiers. In Maths they have learnt about fractions and mixed numbers.
